

Activities permitted in estate based community centres from 12.4.21 to 17.5.21

- Only permit activities related directly to the Covid-19 crisis response (e.g. food provision) up to the capacity of the facility and in line with the building risk assessment and social distancing requirements
- Only permit activities that are related to supporting people/families with personal crisis (e.g. alcoholics anonymous, counselling, education)
- Only permit activities related to education, early years, childcare, children and young people's provision and in line with central government guidance.

General provisions for centre users

- Service User Groups to complete, sign and return Covid service user agreements to centre committees ahead of any delivery returning.
- Social Distancing must be adhered to
- Face coverings must be worn at all times
- For children classes, parents/ carers cannot attend and must drop off/pick up from centre entrance
- Community centre to be well ventilated by opening windows/doors (except fire doors)
- Activity supplier to clean before during and after activity
- All waste should be removed from the centre and either recycled or disposed of safely
- There should be frequent hand washing / use of hand sanitiser
- Must keep and provide track and trace information
- Must check whether participants or household members have Covid 19 or been in contact with someone with Covid 19 or displaying symptoms
- Activity provider must check that participants or household members are not self-isolating

Out-of-school settings and wraparound childcare		Where it is not possible to group children in the same bubble as they are in during the school day, you should keep them in small groups of no more than 15 children and at least one staff member; and where possible, with the same children each time they attend.

Church Groups		You can attend a community centre for a service. When a service is taking place indoors you must not mingle with anyone outside of your household or support bubble. You should maintain social distancing at all times, staying 2 metres apart from anyone who is not in your household or support bubble. Centre hall/ room maximum covid capacity must be maintained.
